JURY CONVICTS MAN OF ATTEMPTED MURDER

Muncie Indiana - Today a Delaware County jury deliberated for 2.5 hours

before convicting Terence D. Walker (DOB 11/5/1983) of Attempted Murder, a Level 1 Felony. A copy of the affidavit of probable cause that was filed with the case is attached. The Honorable Thomas A Cannon Jr., Judge of the Delaware Circuit Court No. 5 set sentencing for July 14, 2003. Pursuant to Indiana law, a Level 1 Felony is punishable by 20 – 40 years in prison and up to a \$10,000 fine. After the verdict was returned, Delaware County Prosecuting Attorney Eric Hoffman said "Today is a great day for justice in Delaware County." The case was prosecuted by Deputy Prosecutors Douglas Mawhorr and Andrew Ramirez assisted by Prosecutor's Investigator Gala Laughner.

The basis and reasons why this officer believes that said arrestee committed the aforesaid offense (s) are as follows: On August 23, 2019 at approximately 10:51am, officers were dispatched to the intersection of E. Princeton Ave. and N. Hartford Ave. in reference to a shooting.

Officers arrived and located George Harker Jr., who had been shot in the back. George informed officers that he was shot by Terence Walker. Witnesses on scene informed officers that a dark blue or black SUV style vehicle was seen fleeing the area after the gunshot. One witness stated that the fleeing SUV was a Saturn Vue. Honesty Knight was with George when he was shot. She was transported to CID to be interviewed.

George was transported to BMH ED and later life lined to IU Health Methodist Hospital due to his injuries. Medical staff informed Detective Dudley that they believed that the bullet traveled up George's chest where it became lodged. George's medical status was described by medical staff as "critical".

At CID, Honesty stated that she and George were riding bicycles in the Morningside neighborhood. While north on N. Hartford Ave. riding on either side of the roadway, a dark colored SUV occupied by a white female and a black male drove by them. The SUV slowed down as it went by them. The SUV stopped behind them and turned around and approached them. At E. Princeton Ave. and N. Hartford Ave., the SUV stopped in between them. Honesty was on the driver side of the vehicle and recognized the driver as Terence Walker from previous interactions. Terence said something to George (who was stopped on the passenger side of the vehicle) along the lines of, "Remember when you stole my car, mother fucker?". Honesty stated that this accusation comes from a previous incident involving the three of them. Terence then fired one shot from a gun at George. Terence then fled in the SUV.

Detectives received information that Brianna Monroe was involved and possibly the white female in the SUV with Terence. Brianna was located at 722 S. Hackley St. and agreed to go to CID for an interview.

Brianna informed detectives that Terence came by this morning and asked if she wanted to "make some plays" (make money through drugs). Brianna agreed to tag along and was asked to drive the SUV that Terence showed up in. Brianna drove Terence to the Morningside neighborhood where they picked up an unknown heavy-set black male and an unknown white female. They dropped the female off at

The basis and reasons why this officer believes that said arrestee committed the aforesaid offense (s) are as follows: another house after driving around the area.

While driving down N. Hartford Ave. they passed a white male (George Harker) and a white female (Honesty Knight) who were on bicycles. Terence told her to stop and looked back at them. Terence asked the other black male if the white male was "such and such" (she could not recall the name Terence stated) and the other black male stated that it was.

Terence told Brianna to turn around, but Brianna refused to do so and told Terence she wasn't chasing anyone. Terence told Brianna to move so that he could drive, so she got into the backseat to allow Terence to drive.

Terence turned around and approached George and Honesty. Terence stopped the vehicle next to George and asked, "Hey, remember me? You stole my car". Terence then produced a gun (possibly a revolver) and fired one shot at George. They then fled westbound on E. Princeton Ave.

Near the intersection of E. McGalliard Rd. and N. Broadway Ave. both Terence and the other black male exited the vehicle in the middle of the roadway. Brianna got into the driver seat and drove away as Terence ran towards the Muncie Mall. Brianna then drove home.

Video footage was reviewed by detectives from Speedway (3300 N. Granville Ave) and the Muncie Mall. Terence and the second black male were seen on video running through the Speedway lot at approximately 10:52am and seen walking through the mall.
