That the eastern half of the vacated public way of (30 feet) shall become a part of the abutting property to the east known as Lot 1 of Block Two and the westerly half of the vacated public way (30 feet) shall become a part of the abutting property to the west known as Lot 2 of Block One.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, Indiana, and such publication as required by law.




