
WHEREAS the Delaware County Commissioners are responsible for Drainage issues throughout all of the unincorporated areas of Delaware County as well as to oversee the Drainage Board as well as the Delaware County Highway Department.

WHEREAS the Delaware County Commissioners oversee and appoint members of the Drainage Board, which have the responsibility to oversee problems and maintenance of legal drains throughout the county


WHEREAS this Drainage Board holds public meetings on repairs and constructions of drains and the board's decisions have a direct impact on the quality of life and safety of citizens of Delaware County. Therefore, the Delaware County Commissioners hereby establish a seven member board to make recommendations and to create a comprehensive plan to address drainage problems in Delaware County. After completion, this plan will be given to the Drainage Board for consideration. Once approved by the Drainage Board, the plan will be forwarded to the County Commissioners who will give final approval through a binding Resolution. This plan will identify problem areas and prepare a list of projects to address those areas that are a top priority.

This Committee shall consist of one member from each of the following: the Delaware County Drainage Board, County Highway Department, Storm Water Utility, County Engineering Department and County Surveyor. One representative from the farming community and one resident of Delaware County will be appointed by the Delaware County Commissioners.
