ORDINANCE 2010-002
ORDINANCE CREATING A PUBLIC HEALTH VACCINE FUND

WHEREAS, Delaware County Board of Health, under Ordinance 2004-005, has received management fees due to certain contracts that it had entered into with the State Board of Health. Said management fees were to remain in an account until the Delaware County Board of Health terminated its contractual relationship with the State and sufficient time had elapsed to bar any potential unemployment claims stemming from the contractual relationship

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance 2004-005, Said funds are to then be transferred to the "Health Fund."

WHEREAS, The Delaware County Board of Health has experienced a shortfall in funding in which to purchase said vaccines.


WHEREAS, sufficient time has elapsed barring any unemployment claims and said funds could be used to purchase vaccine which would promote one of the purposes of the Delaware County Board of Health.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

1. The Delaware County Auditor shall take the funds currently held under Ordinance 2004-005 and deposit them in the "Public Health Vaccine Fund" which fund is hereby established.
2. That said fund shall be used to purchase vaccines for the public.
3. That any donations collected shall be placed in said fund to be used for the purchase of vaccines.




