

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-022

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE WEARING OF FACIAL COVERINGS IN COUNTY BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners in the past had adopted emergency declarations based upon the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has rescinded the requirement for masks at state offices except for state prisons, hospitals and schools; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believe that each office holder should decide for themselves whether to implement a requirement for continued uses of facial coverings in their offices.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


1. The Board of Commissioners shall permit each elected official and department head to determine for themselves whether to continue to require the use of facial coverings for members of the public and employees.
2. Each Elected Official or Department Head shall post on their door or entrance the requirement that facial coverings should be worn in the office.


